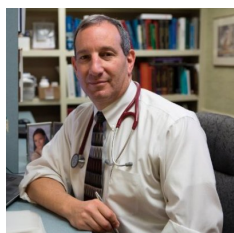




IVAPM's 2019 Pain Management Virtual Symposium
