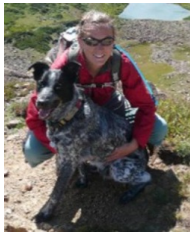

Using Rehabilitation Modalities to Enhance Pain Management

This session will focus on reviewing select rehabilitation modalities and techniques that help relieve pain in veterinary patients. Based on a sound understanding of the pathophysiology of pain and types of pain, we will assess how electrotherapies like TENS and NMES, pulsed electromagnetic field, manual therapy/massage/stretch, and shockwave therapy can add to an evidence-based approach to pain management in a variety of painful conditions.

Session discussion includes:

- Pain physiology as it relates to assessment and rehabilitation
- Review of current data and evidence for each modality/technique
- Applications to illustrate conditions and treatment options

This presentation will provide dynamic views to go beyond traditional pain management, using rehab modalities which offers complementary ways to address pain, primarily when used with pain pathways, and provides a creative and evidence-based approach to pain management.
